Tickets now on sale for Symphoria's July 4th Celebration: Fanfare and Fireworks at the Lakeview Amphitheater presented by Rapid Response Monitoring

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – Tickets are now on sale for Symphoria's July 4th Celebration: Fanfare and Fireworks at the Lakeview Amphitheater presented by Rapid Response Monitoring. The concert will begin at 8 p.m. with a fireworks display at dusk. Tickets can be purchased in advance online at www.ticketmaster.com or by calling the Solvay Bank Box Office at The Oncenter at 315-435-2121. The Amphitheater box office will open at 5 p.m. on July 4 for day-of-concert ticket purchases. All tickets are general admission, and children 18 and younger are free.

The concert will feature patriotic music and renowned local artist [Nick Ziobro](#) along with the [Syracuse Pops Chorus](#). The award-winning Ziobro, 20, has performed with fellow Central New York singer Julia Goodwin and has been featured on "America's Got Talent." The Syracuse Pops Chorus frequently performs patriotic anthems with Symphoria, and consists of about 100 local singers. There will be food and drinks available for purchase at the concert. Seating under the pavilion will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Attendees are encouraged to bring blankets or low-back lawn chairs (no higher than 9" off of the ground) to enjoy the concert on the lawn.

"We are thrilled to bring the community together for Independence Day," said Sean O'Loughlin, Symphoria's principal pops conductor. "Our collaboration with Nick Ziobro and the Syracuse Pops Chorus will provide a fun, family-friendly holiday celebration. We will play classic patriotic songs, like the 'Armed Forces Salute' and the '1812 Overture.' We may even include some Star Wars favorites! What better way to celebrate the United States than with great music from some of its most talented performers, fireworks and delicious food?"

Tickets are \$10 for general admission seating, with free admission for children under 18 years old. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
